We had ten members and one guest show up for our Christmas/Holiday party, which I felt was a success. We conducted a few minutes of business before our food came out. I had mostly discussed what the status of SMART national was.

For those who could not make the party, I received an email from Richard Palmer the 1st VP asking all SMART chapters to donate \$260 to help keep SMART afloat. Below is the email I received:

To our SMART Chapters:

During these winter months, we are not recruiting as we do during the spring and summer as we travel. Currently we are losing 3 members to our gaining one each month. Right now, we only have 806 members paying dues Because of this ratio we are asking for each chapter to donate the equivalent of 4 memberships per chapter which will be \$260 each. This will help us get through the slow period of December thru March so we can continue the recruiting efforts in the spring. If your chapter is able to donate more, please do. Those that don't wish to donate to help SMART stay alive, then we will have to close the doors at the 40th Anniversary 2023 National in Amana Colonies. We are 400 members under our budget. Directions to where we usually camp in Quartzsite, AZ

If you are coming in on I-10 you can take exit 17, or I take exit 19 and go down Main St, that way I can fuel up before I head to camp. From either Main St or I-10 exit 17 go south on South Quartzsite Ave towards the Loves Truck Stop. Turn right before the Loves on to Dome Rock Rd W. follow the road past the Motel 8 until you get to the first paved road that goes left, approximately 1.6 miles from the Loves, Cholla Rd. Turn left and go approximately \(^3\)4 to 1 mile. We should be on the right depending on what area is still open. SMART signs will probably go up on the morning of the 19th when they get there. I will arrive on the 18th.
