Sun Outdoors New Orleans North Shore PV Park is located on the North side of Interstate 12 at exit 47. As you head north from the interstate on Louisiana Highway 445, the campground entrance will be to your right, just before the Exxon “On the Run” service station.

Campground Information:

Sun Outdoors New Orleans North Shore PV Park has paved internal roads and level concrete RV parking pads with 30/50 Amp Electric services with water and sewer connections. Campground amenities include the following one and two bedroom cottages, a clubhouse with a meeting room having ample dining space for a group of our size, there is a smaller meeting room with limited kitchen facilities, this room will be great for seminars, a game room, a playground, a bathhouse, an adult lounge, golf cart rental, a dog wash station, a giant hot tub, a general store, a laundry facility, nearby Exxon service station, high-definition cable with 32 channels, high-speed Wi-Fi internet, a fitness center, this is a pet-friendly campground, sonic drive-in restaurant located in the Exxon "On the Run". The following game facilities are available miniature golf, basketball, volleyball, horseshoes, a pickleball court, walking trails, fishing, a lazy river, and shuffleboard.

Campground Registration:

The Central Region Muster has reserved 36 RV sites and 3 two-bedroom cottages at Sun Outdoors New Orleans North Shore PV Park. 22 sites (8-29) are pull through, and 14 sites (30-43) are back-in. A pull through site is \$59 per night plus a \$10 resort fee in addition to state and local taxes. A back-in site is \$36 per night plus a \$10 resort fee in addition to state and local taxes. A two-bedroom cottage is \$99 per night plus a \$10 resort fee in addition to state and local taxes.

General Muster Information:

Muster Registration hours and detail information will be made available when finalized. The registration fee provides Each attendee with 3 breakfasts, and 4 evening meals. The planned evening meals included the following main courses, 1) Boiled Shimp, 2) Gumbo, 3) Fried Fish, 4) Jambalaya. In addition, there will be a Ladies Brunch and a men's lunch. The menu for each lunch has not been determined. When finalized a muster agenda will be posted by e-mail to each attendee. A schedule of other activities such as games, seminars, and tours, etc. will be included. Two special events are planned 1) a day trip to the National World War Two museum in New Orleans, and 2) a party barge swamp tour of the Tangipahoa River all the way to Lake Pontchartrain. A program booklet with the final agenda will be available at registration. There will be a Flag Retirement Ceremony scheduled one evening. Therefore, bring any United States Flags you may have which need to be properly retired from service.
