FLORIDA SUNSHINE CHAPTER MINUTES OCTOBER 16, 2021 TITUSVILLE/KENNEDY SPACE CENTER KOA, MIMS FL The meeting was called to order at 10:01 a.m. by the President, Leroy Armacost. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by the President. The Invocation was led by Chapter Chaplin, Shelene Armacost Roll call by the Secretary, Sarah Colt. A motion to accept the June minutes as published was made by Shelene Armacost and seconded by Jack Webb. The motion carried with one abstention. Treasurer, Cathy Korvas, gave the Treasurer's Report. *****PLEASE NOTE*****If you choose to register for a Sunshine Muster on the National Smart site, please know that your registration WILL NOT be complete unless you notify the host at the number provided and send all required registration fees in advance of the muster to the host at the address provided. As always, you will be required to make your own Camping arrangements. ALSO: Many campgrounds are now changing the rules for booking rallies. There does not appear to be a consistent policy trough out the industry, but I can tell you that the purpose is to limit unused guaranteed sites. Apparently they are being stuck with empty sites that could have been filled if not held to the last

minute. Simply put, reservations will have to be made by the published cut off date in the newsletter, which is usually 2 weeks or date shown in an email blast. After that date, sites will only be available on a first come first served basis. The alternative would be that the muster master guarantee the remaining sites with a deposit on each site and I don't think that I will be doing that. Getting hosts to step up in a timely fashion is also becoming more of an hassle. If I can't identify an host a month in advance of the start date, the muster will happen as a meals and activities on your own event, or the muster will be cancelled to avoid any deposit losses by the registrants.
