

Recipes from SMART Cookbook APPETIZERS

Bacon Jalapeno Deviled Eggs

12 hard boiled large eggs 7 slices crisp bacon (cut into small pieces)

1/2 cup mayonnaise Salt to taste (optional)

1 1/2 tsp rice vinegar Pepper to taste (optional)

3/4 tsp ground mustard Paprika

1/2 tsp sugar 3 jalapenos (seeded & chopped)



Slice the hard-boiled eggs and remove yolks. Mash the yolks in a bowl, add the mayonnaise, rice vinegar, ground mustard, sugar, salt, and pepper. Stir until well combined. Stir chopped jalapenos and bacon pieces into the mix. Spoon mixture into egg halves and sprinkle with paprika.

Chill until ready to serve.

Deviled Eggs with Bacon

12 hard cooked eggs 3 T sweet pickle relish
1 c. mayonnaise or Miracle Whip ½ tsp smoked paprika
3 bacon strips, cooked and crumbled chives for topping (optional)
3 T finely chopped red onion (optional) crumbled bacon to garnish eggs (optional)

Cut eggs in half lengthwise. Remove egg yolks. Set whites aside. In a bowl, mask yolks. Add mayonnaise, bacon, onion, and sweet relish. Mix well. Pipe or spoon into egg white halves and sprinkle with paprika. Refrigerate until serving.


Guacamole Deviled Eggs

6 hard-boiled eggs ½ c light mayonnaise 2 Haas avocados 1/8 tsp cayenne pepper 1 large garlic clove, very finely chopped 1/8 tsp smoked paprika 1 T fresh lime juice 6 pimento stuffed green olives, halved ½ tsp salt

Peel hard boiled eggs and cut in half lengthwise. Place on tray. Scoop out yolks. Cut avocados, remove flesh and place in bowl with yolks. Blend together. Add mayonnaise, lime juice, garlic, salt, cayenne and paprika. Blend thoroughly. Place mixture into egg whites. Garnish with green olive slices. Refrigerate before serving.
