The Y'all Come is April 21- 25, 2024 in Breaux Bridge at Poche's Fish n Camp.

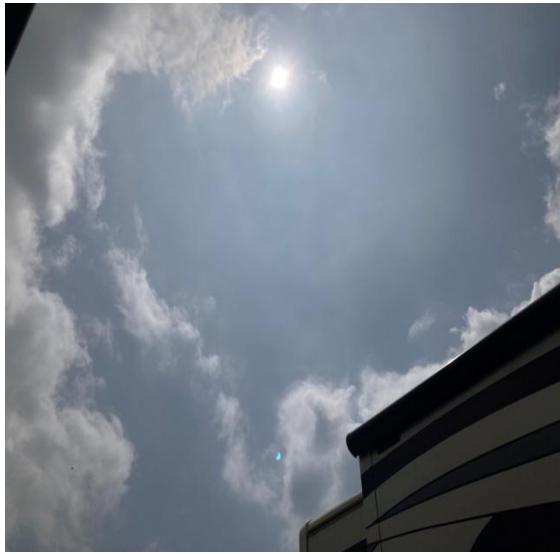
The Central Regional Meeting is November 10- 15, 2024 at Sun Outdoors in Ponchatoula.

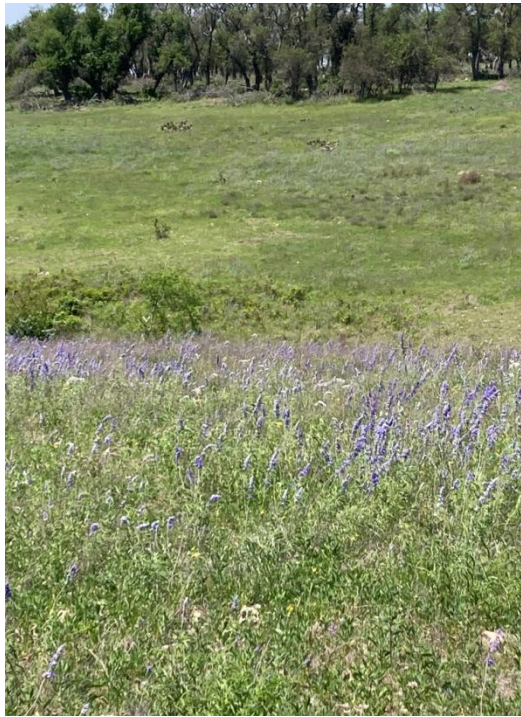
