From the President, SARAH COLT


Dear Sunshiners,



FROM THE WAGON MASTER

Following our upcoming June muster at Seasons in the Sun, our next muster will be in October at Camelot RV Park in Malabar.

The December muster is a return to the Lake City RV Resort. This will allow us to visit the Stephen Foster Folk Culture Center Christmas Festival of Lights. Barbara and I have not visited the park during the Festival of Lights, so we have no firsthand knowledge but you can go to youtube.com and search for Stephen Foster Park's Christmas Light Festival. 



RECIPES YOU REQUESTED!

SUMMER SQUASH CASSEROLE

Spray 9x13 pan

2 to 3 lbsSquash, slicedI smallOnion, chopped

1 can Condensed Cream of Chicken soup

1 cup Sour cream 1 stick Butter, melted

3/4 pkg Cornbread stuffing mix

Seasonings to taste

Cook squash and onion together until tender. Drain well.

Combine sour cream and soup, then gently mix into drained squash.

Stir melted butter into stuffing mix.

Layer 1/2 stuffing mixture into pan, then spread squash and sour cream mixture and top with remaining stuffing mix.

350* for 30 - 35 minutes

RAISIN SAUCE FOR HAM

Makes about 2 cups

In saucepan mix together

1/2 cup Brown Sugar1 tsp Dry Mustard2 Tbs Cornstarch

Slowly stir in

2 Tbs Apple Cider Vinegar

Add 1-1/2 cups Water

2 Tbs Lemon Juice

2 Tbs Butter 1/2 cup Raisins

1/4 tsp Lemon Peel, grated

Stir over low heat till thickened. Serve hot.

COLESLAW

Makes about 16 1/2-cup Servings

Using "S" blade in Food Processor:

Chop 1 Med. Cabbage

2 Carrots

1/4 Mild Onion

Mix 1 cup Miracle Whip

3/4 cup Sugar (or I/2 cup Sugar and 1/4

cup Splenda)

1/4 cup Veg. Oil

1/4 cup Apple Cider Vinegar

Mix dressing (to taste) with cabbage a few hours before serving and refrigerate to chill.
