The SEA (South East Area) Rally is held in Lakeland FL every year. Lakeland has many things to see and do. A couple of members visited The Silver Moon Drive-In Theatre. Silver Moon opened April 14, 1948 - the first drive-in theatre to open in Lakeland. The admission of 35 cents per person included a short subject, a cartoon and the latest newsreel. The Lakeland Ledger stated that the theatre featured 357 individual R.C.A. speakers - a new innovation at the time. An April 26-27, 1948 flyer advertised the theatre as "FLORIDA'S NEWEST MOST MODERN OUTDOOR THEATRE."



Another thing unique to Lakeland in 2024 is the traveling Norman Rockwell exhibition featuring ~300 pieces of his work. The exhibit is on display through May 26 at the Polk Museum of Art at Florida Southern College.

2025 Civil War: Chasing John Wilkes Booth
